### WHY ARE WE HERE?

On September 16th 2022, Mahsa Amini was arrested and beaten by Iranian "morality police" for violating the dress code law, simply for showing strands of hair. The injuries sustained during her custody caused her death, but the allegations were denied by Islamic Republic (IR) officials who tried to blame it on heart conditions.

Mahsa Amini's killing ignited a nationwide series of protests, which have come to encompass a range of issues, mainly women's and human rights. Our people chant "Woman, Life, Freedom" and for the ruling theocracy that forces strict Islamic rules on all the nation to change.

The government has responded by mass arrest of influential people, violence, opening gunfire on the protestors and shutting down the internet to prevent international outreach. Iranians, who have been on the streets for 20 straight days, are arrested, brutally beaten, and shot to death.

#### SHARIF UNIVERSITY VIOLENCE

Shameless Iranian government targets and shoots university students on campus!

Protesting students at some of the biggest universities across Iran suspended classes to show support and stand in solidarity with people on the streets. At Sharif University in Tehran (the Iranian MIT), students were locked into their university by the security forces for hours. During the chaos of students trying to escape and regime forces trying to arrest them, these forces brutally shot live guns indiscriminately at the students, including into student dorms and classrooms. After calls across social media, the people of Tehran came out en masse to block the streets around the university with their cars to stop the government forces from taking the students away.

### ZAHEDAN (A CITY IN IRAN) MASSACRE

Islamic Republic helicopters shoot and kill defenceless protestors and children!

In Zahedan, Iranian Balochistan and one of the least developed cities in Iran, the IR helicopters shot upon crowds of protestors and killed many scores of innocent people, including young children, who were joining the protests.

#### STUDENTS UNDER 18 YEARS OLD

Iranian schoolgirls are braver than the Islamic paramilitary forces!

Young schoolgirls across all of Iran have joined the front lines of the protests. They have been taking their hijabs off in their schools, shouting down administrators and speakers associated with the government, staging walk-outs during school hours and chanting and blocking traffic in city squares.




